



**MINUTES OF LANEAST PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

1.0 MINUTES

1.1 Members considered the Minutes for the Parish Council Meeting of the 4th November 2019. It was **proposed** by Cllr Orchard, **seconded** by Cllr Burden and **RESOLVED** that the Minutes would be accepted as a true and accurate reflection of the Meetings. **UNANIMOUS. Carried**

2.0 WEBSITE

2.1 The Clerk advised the Members that she had been unable to transfer the website the chosen host, due to different systems utilised. It was **agreed** that the Clerk and Cllr Field would continue to research the Parish Councils options and report the same at the next meeting, in March 2020.

2.2 It was **agreed** that, in the event that the website host cannot be changed, the Parish Council should close down the current website and create a new one.

3.0 FINANCE

3.1 It was **proposed** by Cllr Orchard, **seconded** by Cllr Simmons and **RESOLVED** that the Clerk would be refunded for the website costs, which were met from the ARBS Business account. **Unanimous. Carried.**

3.2 The Clerk provided Members with a full breakdown of income and expenditure for the current Financial Year and the current bank balances.

6.0 PROJECTS

6.1 The Members gave some consideration to potential projects, which would benefit the Parish.

6.2 Cllr Simmons suggested that enquiries might be made with appropriate organisations, to enable the War Memorial on the Downs to be cleaned, the writing made more defined and an appropriate demarcation fence erected.

6.3 Members acknowledged that there would be a requirement to liaise with the Royal British Legion and the Commonwealth War Graves Commission, prior to the commencement of any other enquiries. He added that the aforementioned organisations may well have a list of approved companies, which can carry out the tasks required to improve the memorial.

6.4 Cllr Parsons (Cornwall Council) advised the Members that Mr Martin Wright is the Cornwall Council Officer best placed to assist with enquiries relating to this matter.
