Agenda

1.0 Confirmation of Minutes 29th March 2022

1.1 It was **proposed** by Cllr Orchard, **seconded** by Cllr Field and **RESOLVED** that the Minutes of the meeting of Laneast Parish Council on 29th March 2022, be confirmed as a correct record of that meeting. Unanimous. **Carried.**

2.0 Public Representation

2.1 No public representation was made on either :- a) any matter that they wished the Parish Council to be aware, or b) any item listed on the published agenda. However Cllr Burden did say that a resident was concerned about the speed of the tractors and trailers used in transporting sillage through Laneast village. Damage had been done to his property and he was worried that further damage could occur. The matter was discussed and the Cllrs agreed that Cllr Orchard would speak to the individual(s) responsible before matters developed to a more formal and possibly legal basis.

3.0 Parish Clerk. Cllr Burden said that Laneast Counsellor Adam Paynter had put him in touch with a Suzanne Cleave who is a parish clerk in another area but who may be interested in becoming the Laneast Parish Clerk. Cllr Burden had made the initial contact and matters had developed to the interview stage. Matters seemed promising. It was unaminously agreed that Cllr Burden interview M/s Cleave after ascertaining the average/usual parish clerk fees. The Cllrs **unaminously agreed** that if suitable Cllr Burden could enter serious negotiations.

4.0 Finance Matters

4.1 Cllr Burden said that the parish accounts had to be submitted to the external auditors before the end of June deadline. He asked Cllr Orchard to sign the return as he is the Co-signature to the bank accounts. After duly reading the return it was **signed by both Cllrs Orchard and Burden.**

4.2 The financial position from 1st April 2022 to 31st May 2022 was discussed and it was **unanimously accepted and RESOLVED** that the Parish Council accepted the Parish Council's Schedule of Payments and income from 1st April 2022 to 31st May 2022. Unanimous. **Carried.**

4.3 Cllr Burden said that he still needed to change the bank holding the parish's money. He would contact Lloyds bank as agreed to do this.

5.0 Planning Matters Cllr Orchard said that the only planning matter was a slight change to the Tregear House applications. He said that the changes did not affect the overall position and proposed that the council need offer nodo anything. Unanimous. **Carried**

6.0 Correspondence and items to be noted

6.1 **Bus Shelter** – Cllr Burden said that the bus shelter had been installed an he was awaiting the invoice. Once received he would pay it and submit a copy to Cornwall Council to obtain the approved grant of £3,000

6.2 **Defibrulators** - Cllr Burden said that the council needed to say how much they would contribute towards the BLAG defibrulator appeal. Cllr Field said it was a great plan and proposed that a grant of £1,000 be made. Cllr Burden said that he could do this once the bus shelter had been paid for and grant obtained. **Unaminously agreed.**

7 Any Other Business - Cllr Field said that after representation was made to Cornwall Council by three residents of Bagdal re the lorries using the A395 /Tresmeer road and the difficulties they have getting over the bridge just past the Bagdal junction, he had heard that the Council were sending an inspector/assessor to look at the road and bridge. Cllr Field said that they wished a notice to be placed at the A395 junction of the unsuitability of the road for large lorries. Having any signage nearer the bridge would cause problems elsewhere and may not deter the lorry drivers. The parish council **Unaminously agreed.**
